

Valletta's Landfront Fortifications - Restoration of St. James Bastion, Porta Reale Curtain Wall an St. James Curtain Wall De Feo Restauri - Rome (Italy)







The works carried out by the "De Feo Restauri" include restoration, consolidation and rehabilitation of the massive sixtheenth century fortifications of Valletta, capital of Malta, from St James Bastion to St James Curtain Wall, through Porta Reale Curtain Wall. The main aim of the project was to develop and enhance the huge fortified systems, the military architectures and the historical sites of Malta, and to recover ancient spaces and passageways nowaday forgotten.





























Restoration, Enhancement and Development of Nora's Archaeological Site - Cagliari De Feo Restauri - Rome (Italy)





The main aim of the works carried out by "De Feo Restauri" is the enhancement and the development of Nora, in the past, one of the most important port in the Mediterranean Sea, nowadays, the most important archaeological site in Sardinia. Specifically, the interventions are mainly concentrated in the so-called "Central District" where an impressive Thermal Bath building (the largest and the most important of the ancient city) and a Residencial district for centuries shared the same block.



























Conservation and Restoration Works on the Decorative Elements of Quirinale Palace - Rome De Feo Restauri - Rome (Italy)











Restoration works, carried out by "De Feo Restauri", are divided into six different interventions: decorations and sculptures (made by Bernini and Maderno) of the main entrance of the Quirinale Palace - ex Loggia delle Benedizioni; monumental entrance of Via del Quirinale; decorations, sculptures and coat of arms of "Scuderie del Quirinale" Palace; ancient sculptures and busts of the "Coffee House" in the Quirinale's Gardens.
